<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:</u> The Paramedic is a New York State certified emergency responder capable of effectively delivering emergency care and treatment to those sick or injured in various, sometimes physically demanding, situations. The primary function of this position is to provide advanced level pre-hospital emergency care to individuals experiencing medical or traumatic conditions. The Paramedic provides assessment, treatment, and medical transportation of ill and/or injured patients from an incident scene to an appropriate medical facility or between hospitals and/or other medical facilities. The work is performed under the clinical supervision of the assigned supervisor and administrative supervision of the Director of Fire and Emergency Management. Supervision may be exercised over EMT personnel. Will perform related work as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Graduation from high school or possession of an appropriate equivalency diploma recognized by the New York State Department of Education AND possession of a current ACLS and PALS certification AND certification as an EMT-Paramedic, from the New York State Department of Health, which must be maintained throughout employment.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS AT TIME OF APPLICATION AND DURATION OF EMPLOYMENT:

- 1. Possession of a valid New York State driver's license appropriate for the vehicles operated, and a driving record acceptable to the County of Wyoming's insurance carrier.
