The seminar will include information for medical, trauma, and safety response specific to the most vulnerable population in any emergency—children.

- Pediatric Mental Health Crisis
- Care and Transport of the Critically Ill Pediatric and Neonatal Patient in Emergency Situations, including care of intubated children
- Emerging Issues in Non-Accidental Trauma, including human trafficking and asylum seekers
- Pediatric Sports Medicine Emergencies
- Orthopedic Trauma in Children

Nurses, Healthcare Providers, Emergency Medical Services, Public Health, School Representatives, Respiratory Therapists, Mental Health Services, and those that provide care and support services for children.
